

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MANITOU LAKE NO. 442

BYLAW NO. 2-2010

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE PURPOSE OF BURNING WITHIN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Manitou Lake No. 442 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No burning of any material shall be allowed within the boundaries of the Municipality, without the prior obtainment of a burning permit. A burning permit is not required for barbecues, fire pits used for cooking and receptacles used for the burning of household refuse.
2. The permit shall be issued from the Rural Municipal office, during regular office hours, and may be obtained free of charge.
3. Wherein the opinion of the Administrator, dry conditions exist making burning of any material hazardous a burning permit shall not be issued.
4. In burning permit area or elsewhere, whether a permit is required or not, no person shall:
 - a) start any outdoor fire for any purpose without first taking sufficient precautions to ensure that the fire can be kept under control at all times;
 - b) start any outdoor fire for any purpose when weather conditions are conducive to a fire's readily escaping control;
 - c) fail to take reasonable steps to control a fire for the purpose of preventing it from spreading;
 - d) deposit, discard or leave any burning matter or substance in a place where it might ignite other matter and result in a fire's spreading;
 - e) conduct any activity that involves the use of a fire or that might reasonably be expected to cause a fire to spread, unless he exercises reasonable care to prevent a fire from occurring;
 - f) leave the place where he has started an outdoor fire without fully extinguishing the fire.
5. The form to be used for burning permit applications is hereto attached and identified as Schedule 'A' to this Bylaw.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
7. Bylaw # 5-2002 is hereby repealed.
